Attendance Is Mandatory

As part of the Tl'etinqox membership transfer process, all applicants must attend the scheduled meeting. If you are unable to attend, a representative can speak on your behalf.

If neither you nor a representative is present, your application will not be processed.

What to Expect at the Meeting

During the meeting, you or your appointed representative will be required to:

- Introduce yourself (and any children included in your application)
- Explain your reasons for requesting a transfer to Tl'etingox
- Share your family background, including your connection to the Tl'etinqox community and your family lineage

Community Vote

Following your presentation, a community vote will determine the outcome of your application.

The process is as follows:

- Chief and Council will ask if there are any objections to your transfer request.
- If no objections are raised, your application will be accepted and processed.
- If an objection is raised, a vote will be held. The final decision will be made by a majority vote of eligible community members.

Voting Eligibility

Only registered Tl'etinqox community members who are 19 years of age or older—the legal voting age—are eligible to vote.

Attendance is Mandatory

If you cannot attend, a representative must speak on your behalf.

If neither you nor a representative is present, your application will not be processed.

Your participation is essential in honoring our community's decision-making process.
